NAIL SURGERY/ WOUND CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Keep the dressing on until the morning. In the morning, bathe or shower and remove the dressing.
- Clean the area by applying hydrogen peroxide to a gauze sponge. You may scrub the area gently.
- 3. Dry the area with a gauze sponge.
- Apply a small amount of Neosporin cream to the area.
 Cover with a gauge and a piece of tape.

Note: If you were dispensed Poly-Mem bandages, you do not need to apply Neosporin cream,

you ONLY need to apply the Poly-Mem bandage.

- Repeat above process once daily until your next follow-up visit.
- 6. You can expect to have redness, swelling, and drainage **up to 2 weeks** after your procedure. If you experience **increasing** pain or swelling, please contact the office before your follow up appointment.
- * You will be more comfortable if you limit your activities for the next 48 hours.
- * You can take one pain tablet (Tylenol, if no other recommendation is made) when the toe starts to tingle.
